# MUSIC

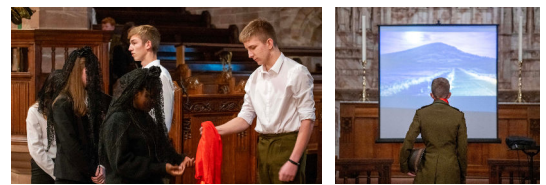


In addition to working hard on the upcoming production of 'Grease', our musicians have been busy playing a big part in events during the school's week of Remembrance.

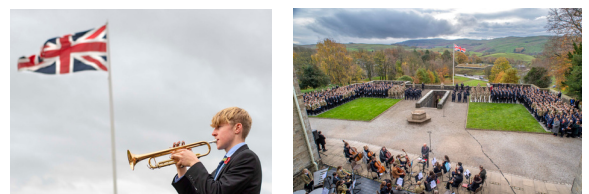
On Thursday 9th November, a number of our singers joined forces with LAMDA students, under the direction of Miss Blackwell and Dr Caun, to produce a performance of extracts from 'A Shropshire Lad' - a collection of poems by Housman, set to music by Somervell. It was a poignant and powerful performance, in the atmosphere of Chapel and with the addition of projections and costume that brought the words to life. Well done to all performers.

On Remembrance Sunday, our bagpipers and orchestra played a prominent part the morning proceedings, not least Alex (H, Y13), who played a bagpipe lament at dawn to an assembled few, and also at the Boer War memorial service. Later on, all of our pipers and drummers played as the school assembled. It was incredibly stirring. Our orchestra accompanied the school's stoic singing, and played two pieces very sensitively as the school laid poppies on the VC memorial. Thanks too, to the Chamber Choir for their singing of 'For the fallen'.

Later that day, our Chapel Choir performed the Fauré 'Requiem' in Chapel, as has become tradition over the past few years. This is an incredibly beautiful piece of music - haunting, solemn yet uplifting and transcendental all at once. Our choir did it full justice, singing with tremendous maturity and musicianship, including two wonderful solos.



Thanks again to all musicians for helping to mark this important week in the calendar. Every so often we award music colours to senior musicians who have made particularly extensive and valuable contributions to the musical offering at the school, and it was our great pleasure this week to award colours to Jack (Y13, SH) for all that he has done as a trumpeter in our bands and orchestra and as a soloist - not least in the remembrance services - and as a committed member of our choirs too.

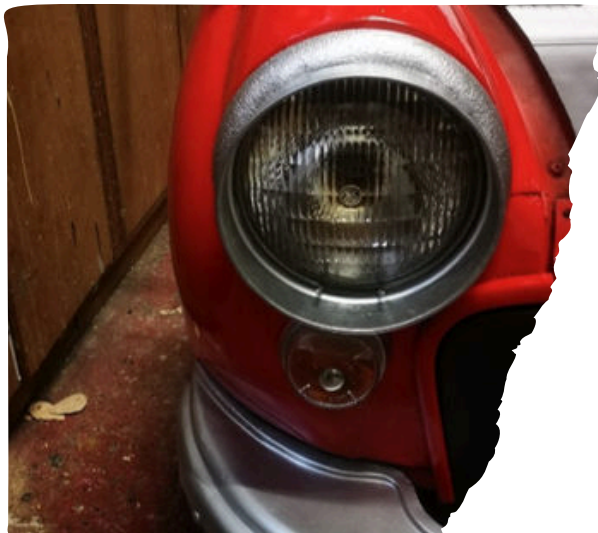
# DRAMA

## WORK IN PROGRESS



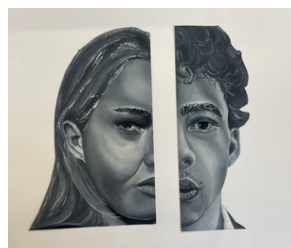

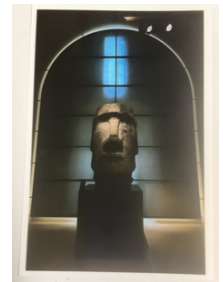

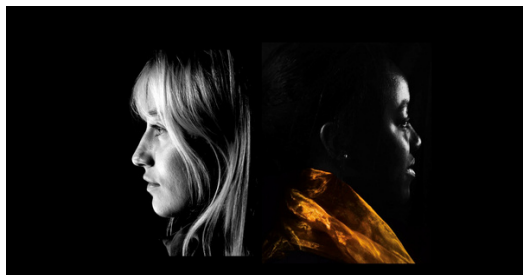
