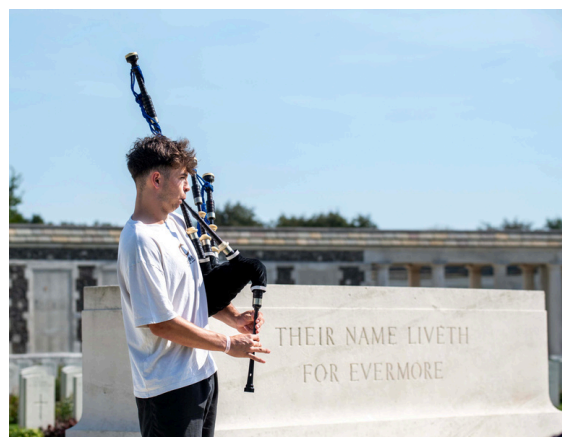

# ART AND DIGITAL MEDIA

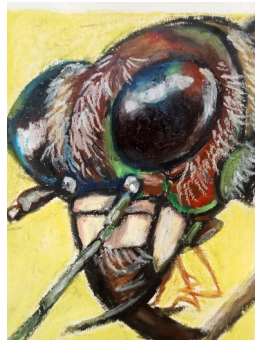
